

Jewish life in Oslo is deeply rooted in resilience, identity, and heritage. Small in numbers, the Jewish community in Norway's capital has played a meaningful role in the country's cultural and historical landscape since the mid-19th century.

Visit to the Oslo Synagogue

At the heart of Jewish Oslo stands the Oslo Synagogue, built in 1920, which remains an active place of worship and community gathering.

Nearby is Det Mosaiske Trossamfund, the official Jewish congregation of Oslo, offering religious services, education, and events that keep Jewish life vibrant.

Norwegian Holocaust

Unlike in Denmark, where most Danish Jews were saved during World War II, 40% of Norway's Jewish population (773 people) were captured and deported to Nazi concentration camps, where most of them they were killed.

Despite this tragic past, the Jewish community in Norway has rebuilt itself with strength and dignity. Today, Jewish Oslo stands as a symbol of survival and cultural resilience, offering visitors a meaningful journey through one of Scandinavia's lesser-known moving Jewish histories.

The Jewish Museum in Oslo

Located in a former synagogue, tells the story of Norway's Jews through poignant exhibitions—particularly the deportation of Norwegian Jews during the Holocaust, when 773 were sent to Auschwitz, with only a handful (34) returning.

(Please note: The Jewish Museum in Oslo is closed due to renovation from May 2026 till 2028)






Begin in the historic heart of the city, **Gamla Stan**, with its cobbled streets and medieval atmosphere.

This Jewish life in the city began in the late 18th century, when Jews were first permitted to settle in Sweden.

From its earliest days, the community played an active role in Stockholm's economic and cultural life. At the heart of Jewish Stockholm stands the Great Synagogue, inaugurated in 1870. Its prominent location reflects the moment when Jews gained full civil rights in Sweden. Nearby, the Jewish Community of Stockholm continues to serve as a center for religious and cultural life.

The Jewish Museum Stockholm

Located in the city center, tells the story of Jewish life through exhibitions and personal narratives. Walking through the surrounding neighborhoods reveals sites tied to early Jewish settlement.

Stockholm became an important refuge during the Second World War. Thousands of Jewish refugees arrived from Norway, Denmark, and the Baltic countries.

The city remembers figures such as Raoul Wallenberg, whose actions saved tens of thousands of Hungarian Jews. Monuments and memorials throughout Stockholm honor rescue efforts and Holocaust victims.




Post-war immigration further shaped Jewish life in the city.
